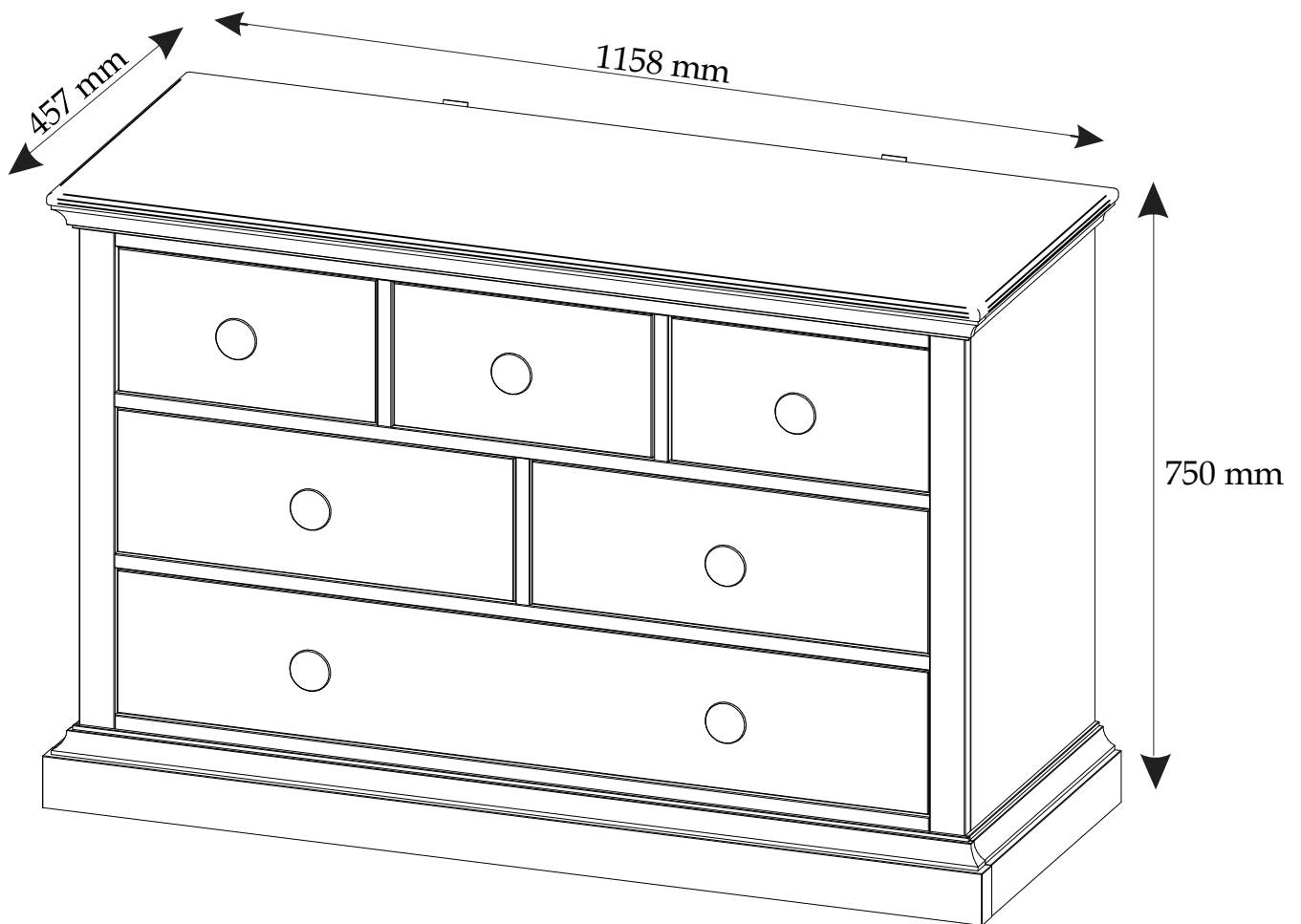

6 Drawer Chest Care Instructions



Caring for your Painted Furniture

To ensure your furniture remains beautiful and has a long life, we recommend you take the time to read our care instructions...

Try to minimise the position of your furniture away from direct sunlight, heat and humidity, as rapid changes in temperature can cause damage to your furniture.

Please handle with care and ensure heavy objects are not dropped on the furniture as this could cause damage to the structure and the paint to chip.

Any liquid spills should be cleaned up as soon as possible using a soft cloth.

Also, be careful not to leave cups or glasses directly on top of your painted surfaces. Instead, always use a coaster to protect your furniture.

To clean your painted furniture, simply take a lint-free cloth and dampen it slightly, then wipe it over the item once a week or so to remove the dust. Don't let the furniture become wet because this can mark it. Be careful if you use any furniture cleaners because sometimes they can contain chemicals that damage the paint.
