




Instructions for use

IMPORTANT, READ CAREFULLY - RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

WARNING: High beds and the upper bed of bunk beds are not suitable for children under six years due to the risk of injury from falls

- Do not use the bed if any structural part is broken or missing.
- Warning! Children can become trapped between the bed and the wall.

To avoid risk of serious injury the distance between the top safety barrel and the wall shall not exceed 75 mm or shall be more than 230mm.

- Be aware that children can strangle in items such as ropes, strings, cords, harnesses and belts attached to or hung on a bunk bed/high bed.

• **Mattress:** This bed is designed to use a mattress size 200 cm long and 90 cm wide. The total thickness must not exceed 15,25 cm. The label on the ladder side indicates maximum height of mattress to be used in this bed.

- The bunk bed meets the European EN 747-1:2012 standards for security and durability.
- The bunk bed meets the Bunk Beds (Entrapment Hazards) (Safety) Regulations 1987

Before Starting Assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on page 3 and 4.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

- Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.



- We do not recommend the use of power drills/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- Regularly check that there are no loose screws on this unit and retighten when necessary.

Parts of your product are produced from solid pine which is a natural product containing a beautiful wooden structure. Direct sunlight can speed up the natural process of the resin contained in the pine knots to change colour around knots. This is a normal process happening to natural wood and cannot be seen as a manufacturer's fault. All wood has been dried to industry standards for furniture timber and all procedures for obtaining the best lacquering finish have been followed.

Our furniture will endure most temperatures in the home but it is best to avoid placing furniture next to heat sources as radiators or fire. Be particularly careful with solid wood as the lack of humidity caused by central heating can cause damage such as warping.

Glue safety - Take care when using glue, please follow the advice below

Skin contact: Remove contamination by washing with soap and water. This procedure should also be followed prior to eating and drinking.

Eye contact: Rinse immediately with clean water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice.

If swallowed: Seek medical advice immediately.

















Safety when using your bed
